

STUDENT WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Refunds or Adjustments:

Students who officially withdraw from the University may be entitled to a partial refund or adjustment of fees, if the withdrawal is completed within the refund period approved for the semester. Undergraduate students should contact the office of the Registrar at (501) 450-5200. Graduate students should contact the office of Graduate Studies at (501)450-3124. Please review the Student Withdrawal and Refund Policy # 612 to determine the approved refund period for each semester. Students receiving Title IV financial aid funds will be adjusted according to the Federal Regulations governing these funds. Contact the Student Accounts Office for information about the Student Withdrawal and Refund Policy # 612. Contact the Financial Aid office for information about Title IV funds regulations.

Schedule Adjustments:

Students who make schedule adjustments (drops) on or after the first day of scheduled classes, and within the period approved for the semester, may be entitled to a partial refund of the difference in the cost of the original class enrollment and the final class enrollment after adjustment. Please review the Student Withdrawal and Refund Policy # 612 to determine the approved refund period for each semester. Financial Aid regulations govern those students who receive Title IV funds. Contact the Student Accounts Office for information about the Student Withdrawal and Refund Policy # 612. Contact the Financial Aid office for information about Title IV funds regulations. Refunds of less than \$5.00 will not be granted.

Certain miscellaneous fees may not be refundable.

Refunds due for credit hours dropped will not be processed before the last date to add classes.
